Required for High School diploma at LABPHS (this type of comprehensive project is <b>highly useful</b> in showcasing student quality to higher-education institutions.)

## **DRESS AND GROOMING REGULATIONS**

Students are to concentrate on cleanliness, neatness, good taste, and safety. The regulations listed below are to be observed by all students at all times.

**Shirts** must be the official school uniform of Los Angeles Big Picture High School and purchased from school. <u>Undershirts must be worn under the shirt, not over the shirt, and may not extend below the hemline of the shirt.</u> **These regulations apply to girls as well as boys.** 

Accessories can be worn as long as they do not contain offensive language or symbols, are not gang related, and neither promote drug use, nor violence of any kind.

**Sweaters/sweatshirts.** All Sweaters and/or Sweatshirts worn on campus must contain the school logo and be purchased from school. All sweaters must be worn with a uniform shirt underneath.

**Pants/Shorts.** Only trouser-style KHAKI pants/shorts are to be worn. Trousers are to be worn at least ankle length but not touching the ground. The hem must not be frayed or ripped, or cut. <u>Pants and shorts must be worn at the waist, not at the hip. No jeggins or tights may be worn as pants.</u>

**Skirts/Skorts.** Khaki skirts/skorts must be the appropriate size and <u>must fall just above the student's kneecaps or longer.</u>
