Parent Agreement

When you as choose to enroll your child at Golden Valley Charter School, you are entering into a partnership. Parents, teachers, and administrative staff share in the education and nurturing of all our children. You are an integral part of your child(ren)'s Waldorf-inspired education. By enrolling your child at Golden Valley, you are agreeing to:

- 1. Educate yourself about the Golden Valley curriculum inspired by Waldorf education. At the minimum, read the information on www.goldenvalleycharter.org/resources.
- 2. Read and agree to follow all school policies including, but not limited to, the Media Guidelines, the Dress Code, and the Behavior Policy. All policies are posted on our school website, www.goldenvalleycharter.org/policies.
- 3. Assure that your children attend school unless they are ill, have a medical appointment, are attending the funeral of an immediate family member, or are participating in an authorized religious activity. (California Education Code 46010, 46014, 18200, 48260, 48290).
- 4. Ensure that your children arrive at school prior to the start of school and are picked up promptly at dismissal time.
- 5. Attend at least two out of three Class Parent Meetings, as scheduled by the class teacher. (Class activities and curriculum are among the subjects discussed at these meetings.)
- 6. Attend all scheduled Parent-Teacher conferences and meetings. (The teacher meets with the parents to discuss their student's progress in school).
- 7. Contribute a minimum of 4 hours per family per month (or 40 hours per year) of Parent Service.

Each year, we will request that you sign a copy of this agreement when you register your child for school. Thank you and we look forward to partnering with you in your child's education.
