How Many Openings Are Available?

Who May Apply?

- Any student interested in Health Careers as a Profession
- Because we are a Charter School
 - Current enrollment in SUSD is NOT required
 - Inter-District transfer is NOT required

Who Should Apply?

- Strongly motivated students with high potential for future academic and career success in areas in the health care industry.
- Students who can, and will, eagerly embrace a rigorous academic environment in high school and also simultaneously take health related courses that will earn college credit.

When Should My Application Be Submitted?

- Applications for the 2013-2014 school year will be accepted from October 18, 2012 through February 28, 2013.
- If the number of potential enrollees exceeds the capped enrollment limit + 10%, a public lottery will be held to ensure equity in placement.
- Applications received after February 28, 2013 can be accommodated only until the capped enrollment limit for each class is reached. At that point, all additional enrollment requests will be placed on a waiting list.
