What must districts do?

Districts must:



Develop and adopt a plan to use the funds and present it at a public board meeting by **December 30, 2021**

Use the funds by **June 30, 2026** to provide training and professional development for teachers, administrators and other school staff who work with students.

Provide a report to the California Department of Education detailing exactly how it spent the funds by **September 30, 2026**

Schedule learning sessions with students, families and community members to invite their feedback as to how the funds are spent
Invite school communities to attend the board meeting at which the plan is discussed and encourage their continued engagement

Questions to Ask Your District

- Have you asked teachers and other school staff to identify the topics of professional learning that they need to promote inclusion and belonging in their school communities and better serve students and families?
- Have you drafted your Educator Effectiveness Expenditure Plan yet after incorporating staff feedback? If so, could you post the draft online for community members to review?
- What investments do you plan to make with these funds and why? When will you start spending these funds?
- How much of this funding is being used for new services versus continuing existing services?
- When and how are you planning to request feedback from students, families and other community members on this plan?
- What metrics will you use to evaluate the impact of investments made with these funds and how will you report publicly on their effectiveness over time?
- Will you commit to engage with the community before making any material revisions to the Educator Effectiveness Expenditure Plan in the future?
